



Thank you for choosing Winter Park Ophthalmology. We look forward to seeing you at your first appointment.

When you come for your examination, we would ask you to please bring the following with you:

1. Your prescription eyeglasses
2. All eye drops you are currently using including non-prescription drops
3. All medications you take by mouth, or a list including dosages and frequency
4. Your contact lens peel packs/boxes/bottles and/or your prescription if available
5. Insurance and identification cards
6. Your referral form/authorization if your insurance requires one
7. A pair of sunglasses

If you are scheduled for a complete exam, your pupils will be dilated. Therefore you should bring sunglasses with you for when you leave the office. The drops we use to dilate your eye will cause some blurring of your vision, usually for no more than 4 to 6 hours. Alternatively, you may elect to have someone drive you home from our office.

Please complete all paperwork included in this packet in order to shorten your waiting time in the office. Again, please pay careful attention to the above list of items you should bring with you.

It is our policy that all visits are paid at the time of service, including deductibles and co-pays as dictated by your insurance plan. We accept cash, check, or credit cards for your convenience. If you require financial assistance, please contact our office manager prior to your visit.
